LEARNING OBJECTIVES:	IDENTIFY HOW TO RESPOND TO EMERGENCY SITUATIONS BY CHECKING TO SEE IF IT IS SAFE TO INTERVENE LEARN HOW TO CARE FOR A VICTIM WHO IS CHOKING LEARN HOW TO CONTROL BLEEDING LEARN HOW TO CARE FOR NON LIFE-THREATENING EMERGENCIES SUCH AS A STRAIN, SPRAIN OR FRACTURE IDENTIFY HOW TO USE YOUR COMMUNITY'S EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) SYSTEM EFFECTIVELY
